At the gateway to the magnificent Scottish Highlands, Kilgraston is also just a 50 minute drive to Edinburgh, Scotland's capital.

Kilgraston is a truly perfect location with the best of both worlds. Stunning mountains, rivers and coastline are just a short drive, along with the famous cities of Edinburgh and Glasgow within easy reach of the campus. Kilgraston itself is set within 54 acres of its own pristine Perthshire parkland, nestled between pastures and forest, the campus is both enchanting and welcoming.

Edinburgh and Glasgow airports are both within easy reach of the Kilgraston campus, offering links to most major European cities. Regular connections to London airports provide an even wider range of destinations via transfer. Nearby Dundee Airport also has a direct link with London Stansted.

All students / groups are met by a Kilgraston School representative to make the short journey to Bridge of Earn. This service is also provided at the end of the summer programme. For students travelling alone, arrangements are made to ensure safe and smooth departure with check-in and passport control.

Upon arrival, a welcome induction presentation is given to all students explaining the programme, code of conduct and Kilgraston Language School policy. Passports and return tickets and any other valuables will be collected for safe keeping.

Facilities

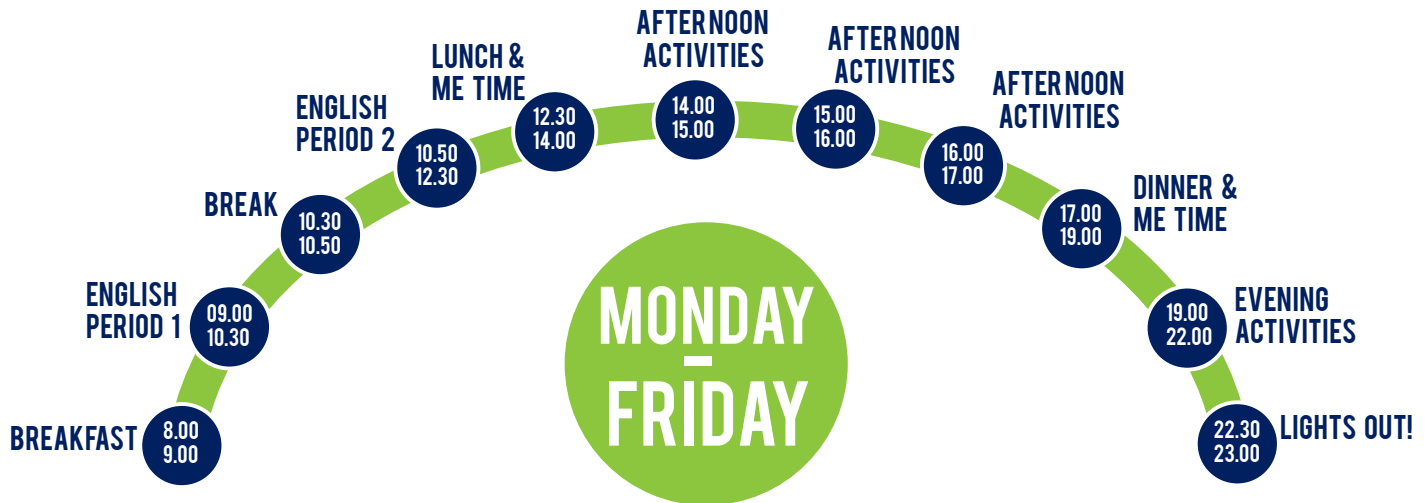

The English language programme has been specifically designed to meet the needs of our learners. Through a blended learning method, our qualified native speaker teachers ensure that students who come to Kilgraston learn, have fun and leave having had a great summer.

The classroom is a great environment where students can improve their English, and when they twin that with the practical application of the vocabulary and grammar in the hockey team, in the stables, at the cinema or visiting a castle, they can really start to benefit from the English they have learned.

English speaking skills, communication skills and integration skills, in and out of class, are a key aim from the Language Activity Centre - as well as having a lot of fun.

Students are divided into classes by age group (ages 8-12 and 13-17) and by level (beginner to advanced). To maximize their experience, a minimum stay of 2 weeks is recommended. However, we do tailor courses to meet the individual requirements of the parents and their children, based on our 15 hour English specific programme that also offers menu specific options from Musical Theatre/Tennis/Equestrian/Multi sport/Discovery for the afternoon activities. All afternoon activities are in English and students benefit from interaction with English speaking students from the local area.

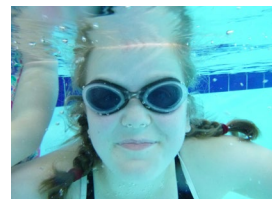
The Kilgraston activity programme provides an integrated and diverse experience for all students.

We think it's essential that all the students have the opportunity to enjoy other activities and some free time with friends. EQUESTRIAN

Kilgraston is the only school in Scotland with Equestrian facilities on campus.

Our Equestrian Centre is well equipped and includes a 60m x 40m arena, hacking track and jumping paddock. We have a good selection of horses and ponies and our teaching staff are fully qualified.

Lessons are tailored according to the abilities of each rider. The emphasis is on progression, variety and fun and each session will combine riding with stable management.

Over the course of the Kilgraston Equestrian Experience students will learn not only how to ride but also how to care for and prepare the horses.



SWIMMING

The programme is designed with your child's needs solely in mind. Groups are ability specific and all children will learn in a safe, fun and challenging environment.

Younger swimmers will learn through fun games and team work and more advanced swimmers will progress their technique and ability through specific and individualised training delivery.

All swimmers will progress their stroke technique, build strength & stamina and develop confidence whilst encouraged in a positive and constructive manner, allowing time to learn independently through guided discovery.



TENNIS

The tennis programme is designed and tailored for players of all abilities, from grass roots through to performance athletes.

A key objective of the Kilgraston Tennis Academy is to allow the students to learn the game in a fun and relaxed atmosphere.

The programme consists of a variety of sessions to help with the core aspects of tennis. Each session will consist of drills to improve basic skills and technique, agility and footwork, fitness and overall consistency.

Based on the player's desire and ability, there will also be a focus on competition and tactics.



HOCKEY

The varied training syllabus has been designed to deliver a programme which covers all aspects of core skill development in a fun and relaxed atmosphere.

From beginners through to experienced players, there is ample room to develop and learn new skills. General game awareness and levels of fitness is also a key theme in every student's development.

All students will be assessed and profiled accordingly with continual feedback and re assessment at the end of the course which will allow the students to maximise their camp experience.



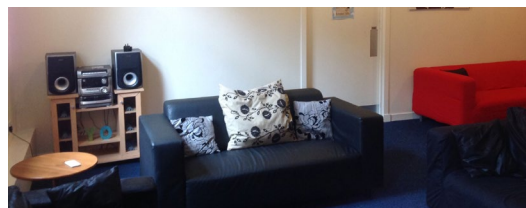
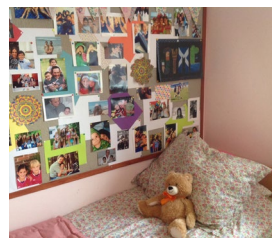
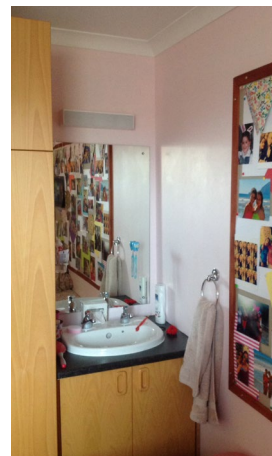
THE *natural* PLACE TO STAY!

Accommodation for students at Kilgraston is both comfortable and secure. All residential boarding houses are on-site and consist of single rooms. A full laundry service is provided for both personal clothing and all linen and towels, which is supplied by Kilgraston, as well as there being free Wi-Fi onsite and in all rooms.

Also within each house there are social common rooms for relaxing and smaller-scale activities. Each boarding house is fully equipped with heat and smoke detectors and complies with all health and safety standards, having had and passed our last inspection in December 2014. Fire Scotland (act) 2005, Part 3.

There is CCTV on campus, for safety and security.

Toilets, sinks and private shower cubicles are located within each boarding house. Accompanying staff members also have private accommodation and bathroom facilities within each boarding house. Each of the boarding houses are connected to one another and they are within 1 - 2 minutes' walk, with the Language School reception as a central point.
